| 1. La Tierra Rocosa Sauvignon Blanc (<i>Chile</i>)
Crisp and refreshing, this wine offers an abundance of passion fruit, grapefruit and lemon fruit flavours. | £3.75 | £4.95 | £17.95 |
| 2. Bantry Bay Chenin Blanc (<i>Western Cape, South Africa</i>)
An aromatic, off-dry wine with hints of tropical and citrus fruit on the nose. Peaches, lemon and apple on the palate. | £3.75 | £4.95 | £17.95 |
| 3. Malandrino Pinot Grigio (<i>Veneto, Italy</i>)
The pale hue of the wine gives hints of perfume, pears and lime. Fresh and vibrant acidity result in an easy drinking wine. | £3.75 | £4.95 | £17.95 |
| 4. Fathoms Sauvignon Blanc (<i>Marlborough, New Zealand</i>)
The bouquet springs from the glass, offering plumes of citrus, green grass and elderflower. | | | £22.00 |

Aromas of grapefruit and gooseberry leap from the pale lemon coloured glass, along with hints of lime, chalk and flint. | | | £27.00 |
| 6. Cloudy Bay Sauvignon Blanc (<i>Marlborough, New Zealand</i>)
A wine full of fresh herbal aromas and layers of ripe guava and tropical fruit. | | | £37.00 |

RICH & COMPLEX

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| 7. Big Bombora Chardonnay (<i>Australia</i>)
Pale straw yellow with youthful green hues. A nose of citrus fruits & ripe apples, with underlying notes of vanilla. | £3.75 | £4.95 | £17.95 |
| 8. Camino Real Blanco (<i>Rioja, Spain</i>)
An interesting & complex wine. Ripe fruit flavours with notes of date and banana results in a filling finish and pleasant aftertaste. | | | £18.95 |
| 9. Chablis Cape St Martin Burgundy
Pale golden colour and a youthful citrus nose with spring blossom nuances. | | | £26.00 |

AROMATIC & EXCITING

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| 10. Oltre Passo Falanghina (<i>Botter Italy</i>)
A brilliant all-rounder, with plenty of citrusy fruit & faint notes of apple & quince, with the merest hint of nutty complexity. | | | £18.95 |
| 11. L'abeille Picpoul De Pinet (<i>South of France</i>)
Light lemon-green in colour, this is a crisp and youthful white wine full of fresh citrus fruit flavours | | | £19.95 |
| 12. El Cante Albariño (<i>Rias Baixas, Spain</i>)
A light, fresh & youthful wine, with a zesty & well defined citrus backbone, overlaid with subtle hints of stone fruits & nectar. | | | £21.00 |
| 13. Fairhall Cliffs Pinot Gris (<i>Marlborough, New Zealand</i>)
Bursting with aromas of pear, honey, apple, spice & even a hint of cream. Hints of sweetness with pure fruit flavours. | | | £23.00 |

SMOOTH & FRUIT DRIVEN

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| 14. Big Bombora Shiraz (<i>Australia</i>)
A medium weight red, with a balance between ripe fruit & savoury. The palate is succulent & mouth-filling. | £3.75 | £4.95 | £17.95 |
| 15. La Tierra Rocosa Merlot (<i>Central Valley, Chile</i>)
Ample red berry fruit combining fresh acidity with ripeness and warmth. Offers good concentration and depth. | £3.75 | £4.95 | £17.95 |
| 16. Los Bailadores (<i>Rioja, Spain</i>)
Violet in colour and soft and fruity in style. Warm, plummy aromas tinged with subtle spice and vanilla. | | | £17.95 |
| 17. Côtes du Rhône (<i>Remy Ferbras, Rhône</i>)
Gorgeous, succulent notes of red and black berry fruit flavours and a warming hint of spiciness. A long and rounded finish. | | | £17.95 |

FULL BODIED & RICH

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| 18. Flor del Fuego Cabernet Sauvignon (<i>Central Valley, Chile</i>)
Fruity flavours of plum & blackcurrant, with a cassis-like concentration, lifted by green-pepper-like savoury tinges. | £3.75 | £4.95 | £17.95 |
| 19. Oltre Passo Primitivo (<i>IGT Salento, Italy</i>)
Ruby in colour, with a nose of warm prunes, dates & figs, with hints of sweet spice. Voluptuous, with toasty notes that linger. | | | £18.95 |
| 20. Capillo de Barro Malbec (<i>Argentina</i>)
An intense red-purple colour, with an equally intense nose of plum and bramble. Fulsome on the palate. | | | £21.00 |
| 21. Espirit de Lussac, Luussac St-Emilion (<i>France</i>)
This is a rich full bodied wine, showing great concentrations of flavour, with juicy black fruit. | | | £22.00 |
| 22. Penfolds Bin 2 Shiraz Mourvèdre (<i>Australia</i>)
A backbone of ripe blackcurrant, cherry and quince overlaid with notes of liquorice, winter pudding and dark chocolate. | | | £32.00 |

ELEGANT & GENEROUS

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| 23. Torre Cerere Montepulciano d'Abruzzo (<i>Italy</i>)
This is a soft, fruity approachable red wine produced from Montepulciano grapes. With notes of warm plum & blackberry. | £3.75 | £4.95 | £17.95 |
| 24. Claro Reserva Pinot Noir (<i>Chile</i>)
A richly fruity pinot noir full of ripe strawberry and red currant flavours, supported by subtle notes of dried mixed herbs and wood smoke. | | | £18.95 |
| 25. Fairhall Cliffs Pinot Noir (<i>New Zealand</i>)
Intense aromas of cherry and cassis in addition to spice, earth, brambles & a touch of mocha. The palate is beautifully balanced with elegant tannin providing a lovely taut structure. | | | £28.00 |
| 26. Châteauneuf-du-Pape (<i>Les Puits Neuf, Rhône</i>)
With typical Chateuneuf power, the wine delivers a fresh & spicy nose of cherry embellished with notes of wild thyme. | | | £32.00 |

ROSÉ WINE

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| 27. Blushmore Zinfandel Rosé (<i>Italy</i>)
A medium-dry rose with ripe red fruits and a touch of sweetness to soften the palate. | £3.75 | £4.95 | £18.95 |
| 28. Pinot Grigio Rosé Le Colline di San Giorgio (<i>Breganze, Italy</i>)
Fresh fruit, such as apricot & peach on the nose; soft floral flavours on the palate & a refreshing, pleasantly smooth finish. | £3.75 | £4.95 | £19.95 |

31. Prosecco Corte Alta (*DOC Italy*) £23.95

Delicate and aromatic with a light body & fine bubbles, this wine carries lots of fresh peach, pear, apricot & apple with a revitalising finish.

32. Moët & Chandon Brut Impérial NV Champagne £60.00

Perhaps the best known Champagne, the Brut Imperial from Moët embodies their house style: crisp and clean, this classic Champagne shows citrus aromas and hints of biscuity flavours. An excellent apéritif.

33. Laurent-Perrier Rosé NV Champagne £75.00

Unusually made by the saignée method, with plenty of stylish strawberry fruit, full of vivacity and easy-drinking charm. A wonderfully refreshing apéritif, it also works well with a variety of dishes.

34. Louis Roederer Cristal £220.00

Light gold in appearance, with fine bead and persistent mousse in this Cristal bottle, and aromas of crushed white flowers, ripe citrus and red berry fruits.
